

OLIVIA GREENWAY visits the iconic paradise islands that are the amazing location for George Clooney's new film The Descendants

N STAGE a string trio is playing, just audible above the hubbub of the guests on the outside terrace of the hotel r. In front of the band a hula ncer gently moves to the usic. I am entranced. "That's Kanoe Miller, by the ly," the waiter tells me. "She's rformed here every night for e past 28 years. She's Hawaii's ost famous dancer." If I were in Las Vegas there ould be fanfare and razzmatazz. ere in one of Waikiki's most phisticated hotels, the ilekulani, it's all wonderfully derstated and light years from e brash, mythical Hawaii of pular culture; Mai Tai cocktails,

ass skirts and loud shirts.

Hawaii consists of a string of six main islands, nearly 3,000 miles off the west coast of America.

Formerly known for its sugar and pineapple production, the islands depend primarily on tourism and film-making, the latter worth £260 million last year. Among the biggest productions of recent times is The Descendants, which stars George Clooney in a Golden Globe-winning performance.

Based on a book by Hawaiian resident Kaui Hart Hemmings, the film attempts to show its more authentic side and is set on the islands of Oahu and Kauai, both of which I'm here to visit.

I start off in Honolulu, Oahu, home to the international airport and where Clooney's character

Matt King has a law business. At first glance world-renowned Waikiki Beach is surrounded by a skyscraper jungle of identikit hotels and anonymous restaurants and bars. Dig deeper however and there is so much more to see.

Alongside the glorious sandy beach are manicured lawns, every designer shop imaginable and a huge array of reasonably priced restaurants.

I visit a couple of the notable historic beachfront hotels such as the Royal Hawaiian, built in 1927, with its Mai Tai circular bar overlooking the sea; the Halekulani Hotel with its House Without A Key terrace bar, where I see Kanoe Miller; and the Hau Tree Lania restaurant where



Robert Louis Stevenson wrote his South Sea Tales.

The next morning I head out to buy a shirt inspired by the scene in Clooney's film where the characters attend a business meeting all wearing Hawaiian shirts. Authentic shirts are made from good quality cotton with distinctive, slightly muted patterns, not the brash designs we see in European holiday resorts.

The Aloha shirt hails from Hawaii and is responsible for the dress-down Friday idea. It's hot here (up to 30C year round) so the shirt was developed as a practical alternative to the collar and tie.

Suitably kitted out, I set off on a irive to Diamond Head, the site of an extinct volcano. I'm keen to explore but a member of a film rew stops me apologetically. They're shooting Hawaii Five-O, in update of the Sixties series.

We get chatting and he tells me iis background is Korean, German ınd Hawaiian. Another resident meet is proud of his English; Chinese and Hawaiian heritage. t's probably no coincidence that imerica's first mixed-race president Barack Obama, with a white

American mother and a black Kenyan father, is also from Hawaii.

In the film Clooney's character, King, realises the importance of family. This makes him change his mind about selling off some inherited land to developers.

With no other scheduled means of getting between the islands, I take a 20-minute flight to Kauai. It could not be more different from Waikiki. It's unspoilt, like old-time America, with one-street towns, brightly coloured houses with picket fences and battered old trucks.

I snake my way up the east coast towards the St Regis Princeville resort. This iconic hotel clings to a rock face with uninterrupted views across Hanalei Bay. Several

scenes from the film were shot here, the most notable in the palatial Presidential Suite. J-Lo, Alicia Keys and Ben Affleck have all stayed here, and pop star Rihanna is a big fan of the islands.

N THE film King takes a jog along Hanalei beach. I followed in his footsteps, but at a leisurely pace. I can't resist some shave ice (very fine, snow-like flavoured ice) from Shave Ice Paradise, which was a favourite destination with The Descendants film crew. I choose vanilla. It's bright blue and dyes your tongue but is the most popular choice.

The nearby Tahiti Nui bar was the location for another scene. A real

local hangout, it's charmingly scruffy with battered tables and chairs and a resident guitarist. I sit at the bar and mingle with some of the regulars who doubled as extras in the film.

"We get lots of film folk here," says one. "It's no big deal. We just let them be." Letting things be is my lasting impression of Kauai as I return to Oahu for my flight home.

The vitality and natural beauty of Hawaii leaves an indelible mark on this first-time visitor.

Clooney may be tipped for Oscar glory, but there's no doubting the real star of this film.
